AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH CERTAIN OPEN BURNING
MAY BE PERMITTED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 91 of the acts of 1975 is hereby amended by striking
2 out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
3 sentence: — Notwithstanding the provisions of section one
4 hundred and forty-two A or section one hundred and forty-two B
5 of chapter one hundred and eleven of the General Laws, any
6 person during the period from December fifteenth, nineteen
7 hundred and seventy-six to February fifteenth, nineteen hundred
8 and seventy-seven, and from December fifteenth, nineteen
9 hundred and seventy-seven to February fifteenth, nineteen
10 hundred and seventy-eight may conduct, except within the
11 Southeastern Massachusetts air pollution control district, the
12 open burning of products of open space land husbandry and
13 management, including materials commonly referred to as brush,
14 including vegetation such as tree branches, brush, cane,
15 driftwood and other forestry debris, but excluding grass, hay, or
16 leaves.
