RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELATIVE TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN ACCESS OFF ROUTE 3 INTO STATE PROPERTY FOR MIDDLESEX COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

1 *Resolved*, That the department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to make an investigation and study
3 relative to constructing an access off route 3 into state property
4 for Middlesex Community College. During its study, said
5 department shall consult with Bedford and Billerica selectmen,
6 planning board members, conservation commission members and
7 interested residents in the two communities. Said department
8 shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and
9 study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of
10 legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by
11 filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or
12 before the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and
13 seventy-seven.
