AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT BY BOARDS OF SELECTMEN OF DESIGNEES TO THE COUNTY ADVISORY BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 28B of Chapter 35 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the second sentence the following two
3 new sentences:— In the event that a mayor, a chairman of a
4 board of selectmen or another member of said board of selectmen
5 appointed as herein above provided is unable to attend a meeting
6 of said advisory board, the mayor or the chairman of the board of
7 selectmen may appoint a resident of the town as his designee, due
8 notice having been filed in writing with the county com-
9 missioners. All designees shall have the power to vote.
