AN ACT TO AMEND THE UNIT PRICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 115A of Chapter 6 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by adding after the first sentence, the
3 following new sentence:— The Council may, by regulation,
4 require that unit prices shall appear in all places where item prices
5 appear for packaged commodities regulated in accordance with
6 this section.

1 SECTION 2. Section 115A is hereby amended by adding after
2 the words "sole place of business":— PROVIDED that said
3 establishment has a sales volume of less than one million dollars
4 per year.
