**AN ACT REQUIRING LOCAL CONFERENCES ON OCCUPATIONAL TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1G of chapter 15 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by chapter 613 of the acts of 1974, is hereby further  
3 amended by inserting after the twenty-fourth paragraph the  
4 following paragraph:—

5 The board through the commissioner shall require that all  
6 school committees and school administrators annually sit in  
7 conference with local business persons in an effort to ascertain  
8 occupational training opportunities for students. The board shall  
9 further require that the school committees annually file a report  
10 of the conference with the commissioner of education.
