AN ACT DELETING INSPECTORS OF PLUMBING AND SEALERS OF WEIGHTS AND MEASURES FROM CIVIL SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 31 section 4 is hereby amended by adding a new
- 2 section, section 4A.
- 3 *Section 4A.* Nothing in section 4 as regards inspectors of
- 4 plumbing and sealers and deputy sealers of weights and measures
- 5 shall apply to inspectors of plumbing and sealers and deputy
- 6 sealers of weights and measures in towns of less than fifteen
- 7 thousand inhabitants.
