AN ACT PROVIDING FOR INTERSTATE RECIPROCITY FOR OPERATORS OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 30, and inserting in place thereof the
3 following:—

4 *Section 30.* A recreational vehicle owned by a person resident
5 in another state shall be deemed to be properly registered for the
6 purpose of this chapter if it is registered in accordance with the
7 laws of the state in which its owner resides, but only to the extent
8 that a similar exemption or privilege is granted under the laws of
9 that state for recreational vehicles registered in this state.
