AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PARTISAN ELECTIONS IN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 63 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 63A.* Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
- 4 special law to the contrary, all municipal officers in cities shall be
- 5 nominated and elected on a partisan basis.
