AN ACT CLARIFYING THE LAW AS TO AUTOMATIC BOILERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 46 of Chapter 146 is hereby amended by
2 adding the following paragraph: —

3 The licensed person shall be in constant attendance of a boiler
4 or engine except automatically controlled boilers that are
5 equipped with safety devices as approved by the Commissioner.
6 Such automatically controlled boilers shall be inspected as to
7 their safe operation not less than once every four hours. The
8 licensed person in charge shall be responsible for the carrying out
9 of the above named inspection and shall cause a log, as approved
10 by the Commissioner, to be kept of these inspections.

1 SECTION 2. Section 49 of Chapter 146 is hereby amended by
2 striking the words "two hundred and fifty" where they appear in
3 the last sentence of said Section 49 and inserting in place thereof
4 the words "five hundred."

1 SECTION 3. Section 49 of Chapter 146 is hereby amended by
2 striking the words "five hundred" as they appear in the third
3 sentence of said section and inserting in place thereof the words
4 "one thousand."
