AN ACT REGULATING RATES FOR HOMEOWNER INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 4 of chapter 175A
- 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second
- 3 sentence, as amended by section 2 of chapter 896 of the acts of
- 4 1971, and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: The
- 5 provisions of this chapter shall not apply to reinsurance other
- 6 than joint reinsurance to the extent stated in section thirteen, nor
- 7 to insurance against loss of or damage to aircraft or against
- 8 liability arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of
- 9 aircraft, nor to motor vehicle liability insurance coverage which is
- 10 subject to the provisions of section one hundred and thirteen B of
- 11 chapter one hundred and seventy-five, including those coverages
- 12 described in section thirty-four A of chapter ninety and section
- 13 one hundred and thirteen C of said chapter one hundred and
- 14 seventy-five, nor to homeowner insurance, so called, which is
- 15 subject to chapter one hundred and seventy-five E.
  - 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 175E of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the title, as appearing in section 19 of
- 3 chapter 266 of the acts of 1976, and inserting in place thereof the
- 4 following title: REGULATION OF RATES FOR CERTAIN
- 5 CASUALTY INSURANCE.
- SECTION 3. Said chapter 175E is hereby further amended by
- 2 striking out section 2, as so appearing, and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following section: —

4 Section 2. This chapter shall apply:

5 (a) to those optional additional coverages which would 6 eliminate in whole or in part the effect of any deductible provided 7 and described in section thirty-four O of chapter ninety and 8 section one hundred and thirteen O of chapter one hundred and

9 seventy-five.

10 (b) to homeowner insurance, so-called, insuring individuals 11 against any, some or all of the risks of loss to personal dwellings 12 or the contents thereof or the personal liability pertaining thereto.
