AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN RECORDS OF ARRESTS AND CONVICTIONS AVAILABLE TO APPOINTING AUTHORITIES FOR POLICE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 276 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 100C the following sections:—

3 *Section 100D.* Notwithstanding the provisions of section one
4 hundred A to one hundred C, inclusive, and of section thirty-four
5 of chapter ninety-four C, the record of all arrests and convictions
6 of an applicant for appointment to a police department shall,
7 upon request, be furnished to the appointing authority of said
8 department.
