AN ACT GRANTING TENURE TO CERTAIN PROVISIONAL EMPLOYEES
WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general
2 or special law to the contrary, no child support enforcement
3 coordinator within the Department of Public Welfare who
4 commenced his or her duties prior to September 1, 1976, shall be
5 discharged, suspended, laid off, transferred or lowered in rank or
6 compensation except as provided under sections forty-three and
7 forty-five of chapter thirty-one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
