AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM FOR PERSONS WHOSE LICENSE HAS BEEN SUSPENDED FOR A PERIOD OF TWO OR MORE YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 24F the following section: —

3 *Section 24G.* The registrar of motor vehicles shall establish a
4 program for persons whose license has been suspended for a
5 period of two or more years. The program shall be under the
6 supervision of the registrar's deputies who shall establish an
7 educational program of safe driving and car operation. After a
8 reasonable time of schooling the person whose license has been
9 suspended would be eligible upon examination to have his license
10 restored if in the opinion of the registrar he is qualified to pass a
11 driving examination.
