AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO POST PEDESTRIAN RIGHT OF WAY SIGNS AT CERTAIN CROSSWALKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The commissioner of the department of public works is hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to post at all crosswalks, except those
- 3 crosswalks where there are traffic signals, signs indicating that
- 4 pedestrians shall have the right of way.
