AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM CHARGE OF A MEAL UPON WHICH AN EXCISE FOR MEALS IS LEVIED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The paragraph defining taxable charge in section 1 of chapter
2 64B of the General Laws, as appearing in section 44A of chapter
3 555 of the acts of 1971, is hereby amended by striking out, in line
4 3, the words "one dollar" and inserting in place thereof the
5 following words: — two dollars.

Section 1. The Commission on the Status of Women is hereby created to study and report on the status of women in the United States.

Section 2. The Commission shall consist of seven members, to be appointed by the President, one of whom shall be the Vice President.

Section 3. The Commission shall submit its report to the President and the Congress not later than one year after the date of its organization.

Section 4. The Commission shall have such powers and duties as may be necessary to carry out its functions.

Section 5. The Commission shall be authorized to receive and use such sums of money as may be appropriated for the purpose of carrying out its functions.

Section 6. The Commission shall submit its report to the President and the Congress not later than one year after the date of its organization.
