AN ACT AUTHORIZING CHILDREN BETWEEN THE AGES OF FOURTEEN AND SIXTEEN TO WORK AS VOLUNTEERS IN NON-PROFIT HOSPITALS UNTIL EIGHT O'CLOCK P.M.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 60 of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out in the last paragraph, added by chapter
3 267 of the acts of 1967, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following paragraph:—

5 This section and section eighty-six shall not be deemed to
6 prohibit children from fourteen to sixteen years of age from
7 voluntarily performing services in a non-profit hospital after
8 regular school hours, but not after eight o'clock P.M.
