## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING TERMINATION OF TELEPHONE CALLS AT PAY STATIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The department of public utilities is hereby authorized and
- 2 directed to promulgate certain rules and regulations providing
- 3 that persons at pay station telephones be granted sixty seconds
- 4 within which to deposit additional coins before his service can be
- 5 terminated.
