AN ACT AMENDING THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE RECORDS OF ILLEGITIMATE CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 13 of chapter 46 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in section 2 of chapter 72 of the acts
3 of 1943, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "ninety",
4 in line 5, the words: — or an illegitimate child whose father has
5 been determined under section twelve of chapter two hundred
6 and seventy-three.
