AN ACT PROVIDING FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF THE CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES BY INSURERS AND THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 113P the following section: —

3 *Section 113Q.* Any ten persons each of whom owns the same
4 type and model of motor vehicle may, if aggrieved by the decision
5 of an insurer or the commissioner of insurance classifying such
6 motor vehicle in a specific category for purposes of setting
7 insurance premiums relating thereto, may appeal to the superior
8 court for a review of such decision.
