## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF COURT OFFICERS FOR THE PROBATE COURT FOR MIDDLESEX COUNTY BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SAID COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 30 of chapter 217 of the General Laws, as appearing in  
2 chapter 642 of the acts of 1972, is hereby amended by striking out  
3 the first two sentences and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 three sentences:— The judges of probate for the counties of  
5 Suffolk, Plymouth and Norfolk may appoint three officers, and  
6 the judges of probate for the counties of Essex and Worcester  
7 may appoint two officers to attend the sessions of the probate  
8 court and court of insolvency of their respective counties. Such  
9 officers may be removed at the pleasure of the judge or judges of  
10 their respective counties, and said judge or judges may fill any  
11 vacancy caused by removal or otherwise. The county com-  
12 missioners of Middlesex may appoint three officers to attend the  
13 sessions of the probate court and court of insolvency of their  
14 county, and such officers may be removed by said commissioners  
15 at their pleasure and said commissioners may fill any vacancy  
16 caused by removal or otherwise.
