AN ACT PROVIDING THAT TECHNICAL ASSISTANTS IN MIDDLESEX REGISTRY OF DEEDS BE APPOINTED SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10A of chapter 185 of the General Laws, as amended
2 by chapter 601 of the acts of 1953, is hereby further amended by
3 striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence:— The assistant recorder in any registry
5 district may, with the approval of the judge, and in Middlesex
6 County, with the approval of the Middlesex County Com-
7 missioners, appoint one* or more technical assistants whose
8 compensation shall be the same as that of the first assistant
9 register of deeds for said registry district, except that the
10 compensation of the technical assistant of the Middlesex registry
11 of deeds in the southern district shall be the same as that of the
12 technical assistant of the Suffolk registry of deeds.
