By Mr. Mullins of Ludlow, petition of William D. Mullins (by vote of the town) that the town of Ludlow be authorized to borrow money for the Westover development project in said town. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF LUDLOW TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE WESTOVER DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of constructing surface drains, sewers, public
2 and the laying of water mains all in connection with the Westover
3 development project located in the town of Ludlow, the treasurer
4 of said town, with the approval of the selectmen, is hereby
5 authorized to borrow on behalf of the town a sum not exceeding
6 one million eight hundred thousand dollars and may issue notes
7 and bonds therefor. Money so borrowed may be used for said
8 construction without restriction as to allocation among the
9 several categories of said construction project. Said loan shall be
10 payable in not more than twenty years from the date.
11 Indebtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess of the
12 statutory limit but shall, except as provided herein, be subject to
13 chapter forty-four of the General Laws.
