AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT A SEAWALL IN THE TOWN OF HULL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct a seawall from Channel
3 street to Ocean avenue in the town of Hull.

1 SECTION 2. The amount necessary to carry out the
2 provisions of section 1 of this act shall be appropriated from the
3 Marine Fisheries Fund.
