### AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN SPECIAL TOWN MEETINGS CALLED IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section ten of  
2 chapter thirty-nine of the General Laws, as most recently  
3 amended by section one of chapter two hundred and seventy-two  
4 of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-six, the proceedings  
5 at any special town meeting the warrant for which was issued  
6 between September 24, 1976, and November 2, 1976, and which  
7 provided for less than fourteen (14) days notice shall be valid  
8 provided that seven days notice of such meeting had been given.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
