AN ACT TO REGULATE THE EMISSION OF NOISE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 31C of chapter
2 111 of the General Laws as inserted by section four of chapter 672
3 of the Acts of 1954, is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 “ashes” in line five the word “noise”.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of section 142B of
2 chapter 111 of the General Laws as most recently amended by
3 chapter 472 of the Acts of 1965, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting after the last sentence thereof the following sentence: —
5 Pollution of the atmosphere shall include emission of noise.
