AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ENGINEERING TO DREDGE THE NORTH RIVER BASIN IN THE CITY OF SALEM AND TO DREDGE THE PALMER'S COVE CHANNEL IN THE CITY OF SALEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of environmental quality engineering is hereby
2 authorized and directed to dredge and to remove all pollution
3 matter from the North River basin in the city of Salem, from the
4 North Street overpass to the mouth of the river and from the Grit
5 and Grease Chamber to the North Street overpass, and the
6 department of environmental quality engineering is hereby
7 authorized to dredge and remove all pollution matter from the
8 Palmer's Cove Channel in the city of Salem.
