AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL OBSERVANCE OF TOUSSAINT L'OUVERTURE DAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 12AA the following section: —
- 3 *Section 12BB.* The governor shall annually issue a proclama-
- 4 tion calling for the observance of the twentieth day of May as
- 5 Toussaint L'Ouverture Day commemorating the life of the heroic
- 6 Haitian Revolutionary and recommending that said day be
- 7 observed in appropriate manner by the public.
