Burke for legislation to repeal the law authorizing the Commissioner of Natural Resources to sell a certain parcel of land in the town of Natick to Silvano A. Melchiorri and Lillian E. Melchiorri; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 936) of Leo R. Corazzini that the Department of Mental Health be authorized to convey a certain parcel of land to the town of Shrewsbury to be used for playground purposes, report recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 5686) ought to be adopted.
