

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF GREAT BARRINGTON TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR BORROWING A CERTAIN SUM OF MONEY IN ANTICIPATION OF FEDERAL GRANTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER TREATMENT SYSTEM AND FACILITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of chapter  
2 seventy-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-five and of  
3 any other law to the contrary, the treasurer of the town of Great  
4 Barrington, with the approval of the board of selectmen of said  
5 town, is hereby authorized to renew federal aid anticipation notes  
6 of said town in the amount of four hundred ninety-two thousand  
7 and five hundred dollars, payable in not more than one year from  
8 their dates in order to pay the federal aid anticipation notes of  
9 said town, dated September two, nineteen hundred and seventy-  
10 five in the amount of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars  
11 which was most recently renewed on September three, nineteen  
12 hundred and seventy-six and payable on December thirty,  
13 nineteen hundred and seventy-six and the federal aid anticipation  
14 notes of said town dated September two, nineteen hundred and  
15 seventy-five in the amount of two hundred forty-two thousand  
16 and five hundred dollars of which was most recently renewed on  
17 September three, nineteen hundred and seventy-six and payable  
18 on December thirty, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

19 Notes issued under this act for a period of less than one year  
20 may be renewed or paid from time to time by the issue of other  
21 notes, provided that the period from the date of an original note  
22 issued under this act to the maturity of any note issued to renew  
23 or pay the same debt shall not exceed one year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
