*Ordered.* That the Attorney General be requested to investigate allegations made in recent recorded court transcripts that person or persons unknown, elected or non-elected, in Massachusetts were given unknown sums of money by officials and or employees of the McKee-Berger-Mansueto Company, who had been contracted by the Commonwealth as consultants to supervise the construction of the University of Massachusetts Boston Campus.

The Attorney General is further requested to investigate any other relevant or questionable matters or allegations in the court transcript, or not included in the transcript, that would relate to the issue concluded by the Court.

The Attorney General is further requested to make known to the House Ethics Committee any findings in regard to current House members.
