AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONVEY TWO CERTAIN PARCELS OF LAND SITUATED IN THE DORCHESTER DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON TO THE PROVIDENT INSTITUTION FOR SAVINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Metropolitan District Commission is hereby authorized to
2 convey to the Provident Institution for Savings in the City of
3 Boston two certain parcels of land situated in the Dorchester
4 District of Boston, Suffolk County, Massachusetts, for such
5 consideration as may be determined by the Metropolitan District
6 Commission.

7 Said two certain parcels of land are bounded and described as
8 follows:

9 Parcel 1: Northeasterly by William T. Morrissey Boulevard, 43
10 feet, more or less; southerly by land now or formerly of John and
11 Nina DeSimone, 50.32 feet; westerly by land now or formerly of
12 Herbert and Eileen B. Mansfield, 38 feet; and northerly by land of
13 owners unknown, 29.34 feet.

14 Parcel 2: Northeasterly by William T. Morrissey Boulevard,
15 23.7 feet, more or less; southerly by a parcel of land registered by
16 the Land Court as Land Court Case No. 24773, 17.15 feet; and
17 northwesterly by land now or formerly of Ralph C. and Helen F.
18 Holmberg and John and Nina DeSimone, by two lines measuring
19 15.20 feet, respectively.
