AN ACT TO ROLL BACK TO JANUARY 1, 1975 THE AUTOMOBILE RATES FOR ALL TYPES OF INSURANCE COVERAGE AND TO FREEZE SAME UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 To roll back to January 1, 1975 the automobile rates for all
- 2 types of insurance coverage and to freeze same until further
- 3 notice.
