AN ACT AMENDING WORK LIENS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 31A of Chapter 255 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by Chapter 143 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking section 31A, and replacing it with the  
4 following new section: —

5 *Section 31A.* A lien on account of work, labor, and materials  
6 furnished in the spinning, throwing, manufacturing, bleaching,  
7 mercerizing, dyeing, printing, finishing or otherwise processing of  
8 cotton, wool, silk, artificial silk or synthetic fibers, or of leather  
9 goods or hides, or of goods of which cotton, wool, silk, artificial  
10 silk or synthetic fibers form a component part and the processing  
11 of wood, metals, paper, paperboard, plastic and the processing of  
12 any material for use in electrical components and assembly of same  
13 covering the addition of materials and labor furnished as against  
14 goods in the lienor's possession, shall extend to any unpaid balance  
15 of account for work, labor and materials furnished in the course of  
16 any such process in respect of any other such goods of the same  
17 owner whereof the lienor's possession has terminated. The word  
18 "owner", as used in this and in the following section, shall include a  
19 factor, consignee or other agent entrusted with the possession of  
20 the goods held under said lien or of a bill of lading consigning the  
21 same to him with authority to sell the same, and delivered by such  
22 factor, agent or consignee to the lienor for the purposes aforesaid.
