AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE WACHUSETT REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE FOR THE WITHDRAWAL OF A MEMBER TOWN AND VALIDATING THE ADOPTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT AGREEMENT FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The amendment to the Wachusett Regional  
2 School District agreement providing for a method by which a  
3 member town can withdraw from the District, which was approved  
4 at town meetings in the towns of Holden, Paxton, Princeton,  
5 Rutland and Sterling is hereby validated and confirmed in all  
6 respects.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
