The committee on Insurance, to whom were recommitted the Bill authorizing a local governmental unit to enter into administrative services contracts providing hospital, surgical, medical, dental and other health care benefits on behalf of active and retired municipal employees and their dependents and the establishment of a claims trust fund (House, No. 3735); and the Bill authorizing the Group Insurance Commission to enter into administrative services contracts on behalf of active and retired state employees and their dependents and the establishment of a revolving claims fund (printed in House, No. 5324), report recommending that the accompanying order (House, No. 6322) ought to be adopted.

Ordered, That the joint special committee, established (under the provisions of an order, see House No. 5049 of 1971 and most recently revived and continued under the provisions of an order, see House No. 000 of 1977) to make an investigation and study of health benefits and health services for every citizen of the commonwealth and related matters, shall, in the course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of current house documents numbered: 3725, that local government units be authorized to enter into administrative services contracts providing hospital, surgical, medical, dental and other health care benefits on behalf of active and retired municipal employees and their dependents and relative to the establishment of a claims trust fund; and 5324, relative to authorizing the Group Insurance Commission to enter into administrative services contracts on behalf of active and retired state employees and their dependents and the establishment of a revolving claims fund.
