By Mr. Flynn of Amesbury, petition of Bernard D. Flynn and Sharon M. Pollard that the Department of Public Health be directed to make a certain determination of need for the Amesbury Hospital. Health Care.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO MAKE A CERTAIN DETERMINATION OF NEED FOR THE AMESBURY HOSPITAL.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is, to provide for the approval of certain projects
3 relative to the Amesbury Hospital by the department of public
4 health, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,
5 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public con-
6 venience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections twenty-five C of
2 chapter one hundred and eleven of the General Laws or any other
3 general or special law, the department of public health is hereby
4 authorized and directed to make an affirmative determination of
5 need as set forth in said section twenty-five C of said chapter one
6 hundred and eleven as to the project described in an application for
7 such a determination submitted by the Amesbury Hospital and
8 numbered Project No. 8-2588 and to approve said project.
