AN ACT RELATIVE TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of any general or
2 special act, such ordinances or regulations as may be promulgated
3 by the City of Worcester relative to or in connection with direction
4 signs, warning signs and lights, mechanical traffic signal systems,
5 traffic devices, parking meters, and curb, street or other traffic
6 markings, on any way within the control of said city, provided that
7 the same are in accordance with accepted standards of engineering
8 practice, shall be effective without the necessity of obtaining
9 approval of the department of public works, and without loss of
10 any payment or reimbursement by the Commonwealth otherwise
11 available to the said City.
