## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

*Ordered*, That House Rule 68 be amended by inserting after the third sentence the following:

All members in the chamber when it is announced by the presiding officer in the chair that a roll call is about to take place, must, before a roll call is opened, proceed to their own seats and be seated and must then remain seated in their own seats until the roll call machine is closed and it is so announced by the presiding officer in the chair.

Members arriving in the chamber after the roll call machine has been opened must go directly to their own seats and be seated, and must remain seated in their own seats until the roll call machine is closed and it is so announced by the presiding officer in the chair.

When the roll call machine has been opened the doors to the House Chamber shall be locked for the duration of the roll call except to admit members who enter the chamber after the roll call machine has been opened and before it has been closed.
