RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO CERTAIN IMPASSE PROCEDURES INVOLVING MUNICIPAL FIREFIGHTERS AND POLICE OFFICERS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission to consist of the House and
2 Senate Chairmen of the Joint Committee on Public Service and
3 nine persons to be appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall
4 be a representative of the Massachusetts League of Cities and
5 Towns, one of whom shall be a representative of the Professional
6 Firefighters of Massachusetts, one of whom shall be a representa-
7 tive of the Massachusetts Board of Conciliation and Arbitra-
8 tion, one of whom shall be a representative of the International
9 Brotherhood of Police Officers, one of whom shall be a
10 representative of the Massachusetts Fire Chief's Association, and
11 one of whom shall be a representative of the Massachusetts
12 Mayor's Association, for the purpose of making an investigation
13 and study relative to the impasse procedures contained in the
14 Massachusetts collective bargaining laws.
