AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASED FINE ON TRAFFIC VIOLATORS FOR FAILURE TO RESPOND WITHIN TWENTY-ONE DAYS OF NOTICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first sentence of the fifth paragraph of section 20C of
2 chapter 90 of the General Laws as amended by chapter 119 of the
3 acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by inserting after the word
4 "dollars", in line 10, the words: — if paid within twenty-one days or
5 twenty dollars if paid thereafter.
