## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNIT OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION POLICE.

1     *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat  
2 its purpose, which is to establish a collective bargaining unit within  
3 the metropolitan district commission police, therefore it is hereby  
4 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate  
5 preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     Section 3 of chapter 150E of the General Laws, as amended by  
2 chapter 591 of the acts of 1975, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding the following paragraph: —

4     The appropriate bargaining unit in the case of the metropolitan  
5 district commission police for officers subordinate to the rank of  
6 captain shall be composed of members of the metropolitan district  
7 commission police holding and in the rank of lieutenant, sergeant,  
8 patrolwoman and patrolman.
