The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A CERTAIN NUMBER OF PARKING SPACES IN
MUNICIPAL OFF-STREET PARKING AREAS BE RESERVED FOR VEHICLES
OF HANDICAPPED PERSONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 22B of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 2 of chapter 183 of the acts of 1973, is hereby
3 further amended by adding the following sentence:— When the
4 number of parking spaces in any such area is more than one but not
5 more than twenty-five, one parking space, more than twenty-five
6 but not more than forty, five per cent of such spaces but not less
7 than two, more than forty but not more than one hundred, four per
8 cent of such spaces but not less than three, more than one hundred
9 but not more than two hundred, three per cent of such spaces but
10 not less than four, more than two hundred but not more than five
11 hundred, two per cent of such spaces but not less than six, more
12 than five hundred but not more than one thousand, one and one-
13 half per cent of such spaces but not less than ten, more than one
14 thousand but not more than two thousand, one per cent of such
15 spaces but not less than fifteen, more than two thousand but less
16 than five thousand, three-fourths of one per cent of such spaces but
17 not less than twenty and more than five thousand, one-half of one
18 per cent of such spaces but not less than thirty.
