AN ACT AUTHORIZING A MEALS TAX EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN
HANDICAPPED PERSONS LIVING IN ELDERLY HOUSING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Paragraph (cc) of section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws,
- 2 as appearing in section 47 of chapter 363 of the acts of 1977, is
- 3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "over", in line 12, the
- 4 following words: — or to elderly or handicapped persons residing
- 5 in a housing project qualifying under sections thirty-eight to forty,
- 6 inclusive, of chapter one hundred and twenty-one B.
