## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR EXPANSION AND CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE ST. JOHN OF GOD HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter seven hundred and  
2 seventy-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and seventy-two or any  
3 other contrary provisions of law, the commissioner of public  
4 health is hereby authorized and directed to issue a certificate of  
5 need to St. John of God Hospital, Inc. and an appropriate hospital  
6 license to St. John of God Hospital, Inc. to authorize the  
7 construction and operation thereof of a new hospital facility  
8 containing sixty chronic disease beds and ancillary services at the  
9 estimated capital expenditure of four million dollars.
