

By Mr. Sheets of Quincy, petition of James A. Sheets that the Department of Environmental Management be authorized to grant or convey a certain easement in the Myles Standish State Forest located in the town of Plymouth to Florence Guild Nixon. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Seven.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT, TO GRANT OR CONVEY A CERTAIN EASEMENT THROUGH A PORTION OF MYLES STANDISH STATE FOREST, PLYMOUTH, MASSACHUSETTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of  
2 general or special law, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,  
3 Department of Environmental Management by its Director, may  
4 grant or convey to Florence Guild Nixon, her heirs and assigns, an  
5 easement for the purpose of the transmission of electricity and  
6 intelligence together with all appurtenant rights normally  
7 associated with such transmission, through that portion of the  
8 Myles Standish State Forest in Plymouth, Massachusetts, as  
9 follows along and is parallel to College Pond Road or Snake Hill  
10 Road, so called, for a width of fifteen feet running the entire length  
11 of said College Pond Road or Snake Hill Road, so called, as it  
12 passes through the said State Forest, being a distance of  
13 approximately three thousand feet.

1 SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of Environmen-  
2 tal Management, in the name and on behalf of the Commonwealth  
3 of Massachusetts, shall execute and deliver any instrument  
4 necessary to grant or convey such easement under the authority of  
5 the Act.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
