RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE  
TO THE PROBLEMS CONCERNING ARSON.

1     *Resolved*, That the special commission, established by chapter  
2 four of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-six and  
3 revived and continued under the provisions of chapter seventeen of  
4 the resolves of nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, shall, in the  
5 course of its investigation and study, consider the subject matter of  
6 current house documents numbered 518, providing that the  
7 commissioner of public safety be authorized to designate a  
8 member of a police department of a city or town to investigate fires  
9 of suspicious origin occurring in such municipalities; and 5375,  
10 relative to increasing certain provisions of certain fire insurance  
11 policies and contracts.
