

Accompanying the fifteenth recommendation of the Department of Highways (House, No. 112). Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 16 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended at line
3 12 by inserting, after the words "district highway engineers", the
4 words — district construction engineers, district maintenance
5 engineers, district project engineers; and at line 28 by striking out
6 the word "or".

1 SECTION 2. Said section 4 of chapter 16 is further amended
2 at line 18 by striking out the word "thirty-five" and inserting in
3 place thereof the word — fifty-nine.

1 SECTION 3. Said Section 4 of chapter 16 is further amended
2 at line 19 by inserting, after the words "district highway engineer",
3 the words — district construction engineer or district project
4 engineer; and at line 35 by inserting, after the words "college or
5 university" the following sentence: — Any person appointed to
6 the position of district maintenance engineer shall be (1) an
7 employee of the Department holding a permanent position
8 classified under chapter thirty-one and shall be a person of
9 experience and skill in the maintenance of highways and bridges;
10 or (2) shall meet the eligibility requirements for appointment to
11 an engineering position pursuant to this paragraph.
