AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE OCCUPATIONAL BLOOD LEAD REGISTRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11A of chapter 149 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out, in line 9, the words "fifteen" and inserting in place
4 thereof the following word: — fourteen.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 11A of said chapter 149 is hereby
2 further amended by striking out the second and third sentences
3 of the fifth paragraph and striking out the sixth paragraph and
4 inserting in place thereof the following: — Whoever violates any
5 rule, regulation or requirement made by the department under
6 authority hereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than five
7 hundred dollars for each offense. The department or its
8 representative or any person aggrieved, any interested party or
9 any officer of any labor union or association, whether
10 incorporated or otherwise, may file a written complaint with the
11 district court in the jurisdiction of which the violation occurs.
