

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 478, 479.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 40 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 4G the following section:-

Section 4H. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections four B, four G or section twenty-three of chapter forty-three or of any other general or special law to the contrary, any city, town or regional school district, which accepts the provisions of this section, may purchase and enter into contracts to purchase equipment, supplies and materials from any agency or instrumentality of the federal government, the commonwealth or any of its political subdivisions.

**Chap. 478. AN ACT VALIDATING CERTAIN ACTION TAKEN BY THE TOWN OF SWANSEA AT A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING IN THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO.**

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the vote taken at the special town meeting of the town of Swansea, held on November 19, 1962 to adopt, by unanimous consent, Article Four of the Warrant as an amendment to the Zoning District Map, is hereby certified, validated, confirmed and declared to be a valid amendment to the Zoning District Map in the Town of Swansea, notwithstanding the fact that the amendment was not subsequently filed with the Department of the Attorney General.

**Chap. 479. AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR HAROLD F. MacGILVARY, JR., A POLICE OFFICER OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION POLICE.**

Section 2 of chapter 154 of the acts of 1983 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the words "said retirement board"
