AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RIGHT OF PRIVACY OF EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 52C the following section: —
- 3 Section 52D. No employer or agent thereof shall maintain any
- 4 records of the charitable or political contribution of any employee
- 5 or vendor.
